The National Service Scheme (NSS) is a Central Sector Scheme of Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports. National Service Scheme (NSS) was introduced in 1969 with the primary objective of the personality and character of the student youth through voluntary community service. 'Education through Service' is the purpose of the NSS. The ideological orientation of the NSS is inspired by the ideals of Mahatma Gandhi. Very appropriately, the motto of NSS is "NOT ME, BUT YOU". An NSS volunteer places the 'community' before 'self'. The NSS Unit consists of 100 student volunteers. The Program Officer is expected to motivate the student youth to understand the values and philosophy of NSS. The overall functions of Program Officer are to help the students to plan, implement and evaluate the activities of NSS under his/her charge and give proper guidance and directions to the student volunteers.

Rashtrasant Tukadoji maharaj Nagpur University has been participating in the Scheme right from its inception. There are few number of colleges who runs this scheme and we have great privilege that our college Shri Shivaji Science College Nagpur had manage to conduct this scheme every year. The N.S.S unit in order to begin the new year with its new members started with the enrolment procedure from 23rd July 2020. Out of the 356 applications that the organizations received, and selected 100 volunteer for the session 2019-2020 after the Brain storming selection process that included a round of Group Discussion and Personal Interviewed.
