IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

6th November, 2023


All the students of B.Sc. and BCA Semester I/ III / V are hereby informed to follow the given instructions for the End Semester Examination Winter-2023.

1. This Examination is University Examination conducted by R.T.M. Nagpur University, Nagpur at Home Centre for B.Sc. and BCA Semester I/ III / V students, it is mandatory for all the students to appear in the Examination.
2. Student should report the Home Examination Centre prior half an hour (30 minutes) from the time of commencement of examination as per the given schedule and are not allowed to enter in the Examination Hall after 1.45 p.m. for afternoon shift.
3. Student should be in proper College Uniform along with I-Card.
4. Electronic gadgets and any of the valuable things are not allowed in the Examination Hall.
5. Scientific Calculators will be allowed only when it is required with the prior permission of the invigilator.
6. Students should write the Roll Numbers legibly on the Answer Book provided by University. In case the roll numbers are not provided by University then Students are advised to check the Roll list (Provided by College) displayed on the notice board and website.
7. The students must ensure that they have signed the attendance sheet before they leave the examination hall.
8. Students will occupy only the allotted seat as per seating plan.
9. Students should write the serial number of the main answer book along with signature on the invigilator diary provided/ Attendance Sheet.
10. Students are advised to refer to college website everyday for examination related updated information.
11. For any queries regarding the Roll Number student should contact Shri Sanjay Barapatre in college office and regarding seating arrangement contact Examination In-Charge.
12. Student may carry transparent water bottles.
13. As the answer book provided will be thick, so no cardboard is required.

14. Student may wear Chappals /Sandals (no shoes are allowed inside the Examination Hall).
15. Once students are seated in the Examination hall for examination they are not expected to have any sort of communication among themselves. These cases shall be considered as malpractice.
16. Students are not allowed to scribble on the Question Papers. Scribbling on the Question Paper is considered as an act of malpractice. Students are supposed to write only their Roll No. on top of their question paper.
17. Students are not supposed to tear any page from the answer book. They may use the last page in the answer book for rough work and strike the contents in the rough work page afterwards.
18. Students are requested to cross out the blank pages with cross mark (X).
19. Students are not allowed to have additional sheet for the Examinations. All the answers are to be written in the main answer booklet itself (contains 32 Pages).
20. If any Candidate caught with any unauthorized material, he/she should be immediately sent to Examination Control Room. The unauthorized material will be tagged to the Answer Book, and the invigilator will mark the first page of answer book across in red as 'Malpractice Case'.
21. Disciplinary action will be taken against the student using unfair means and the matter will be informed to their parents and further action will be taken by higher authority.
