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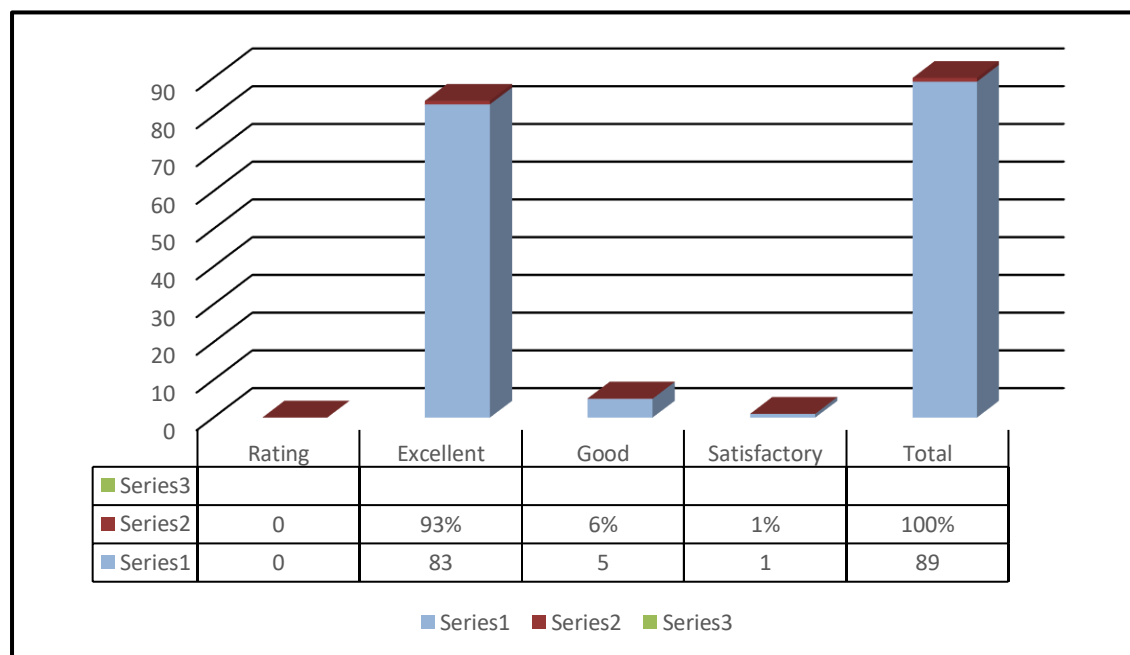

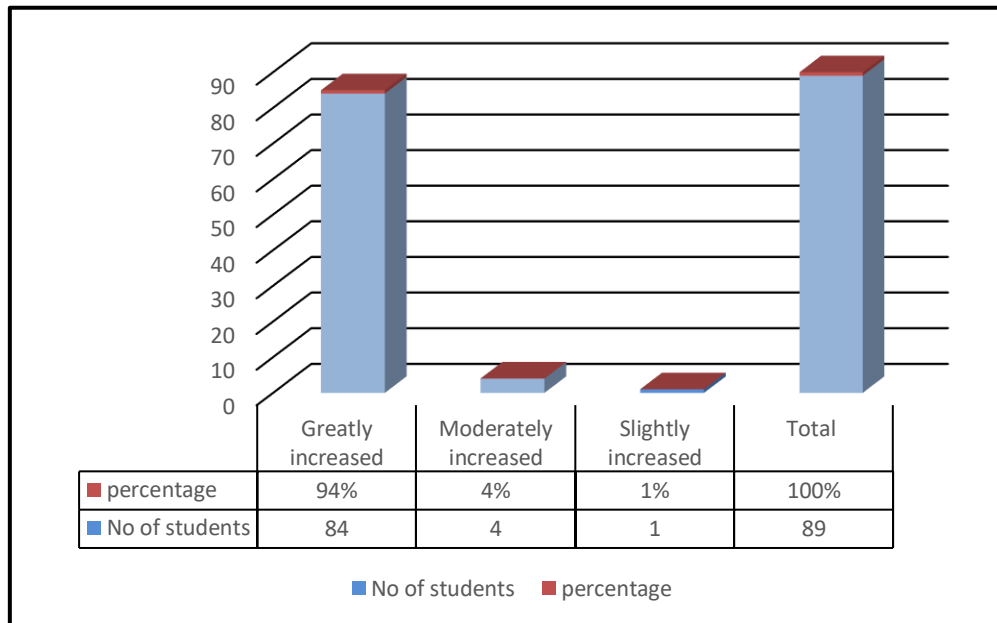
Q.1) How would you rate the overall organization of the competition?

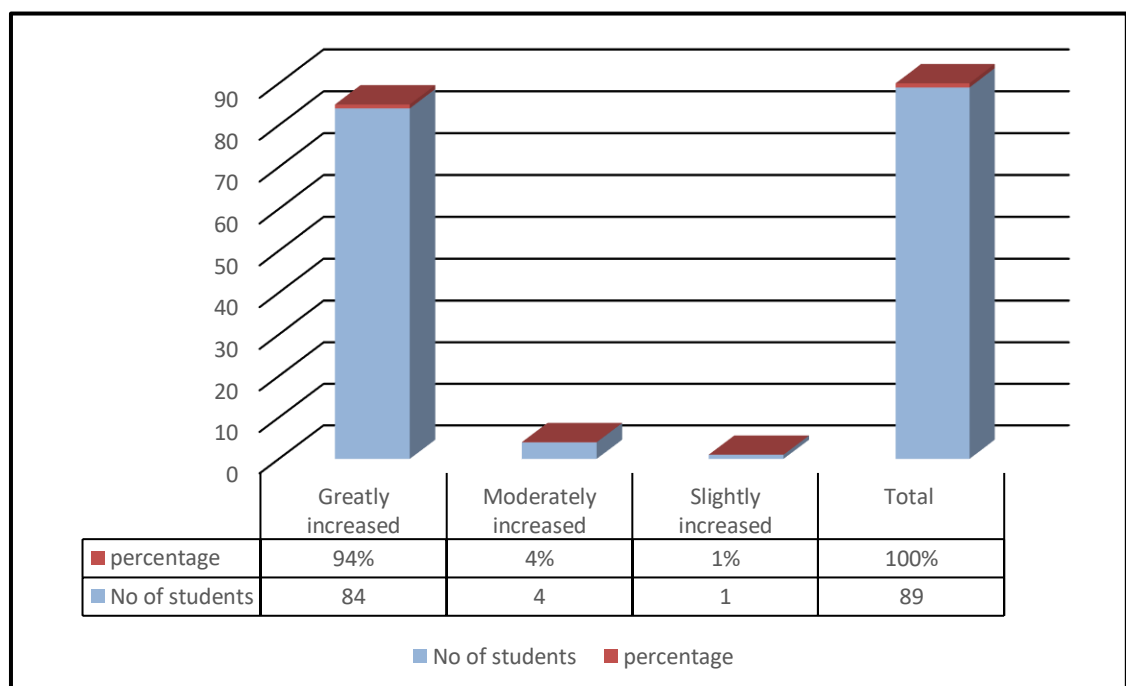
### Q.2) How effectively did the competition drive creativity and innovation?

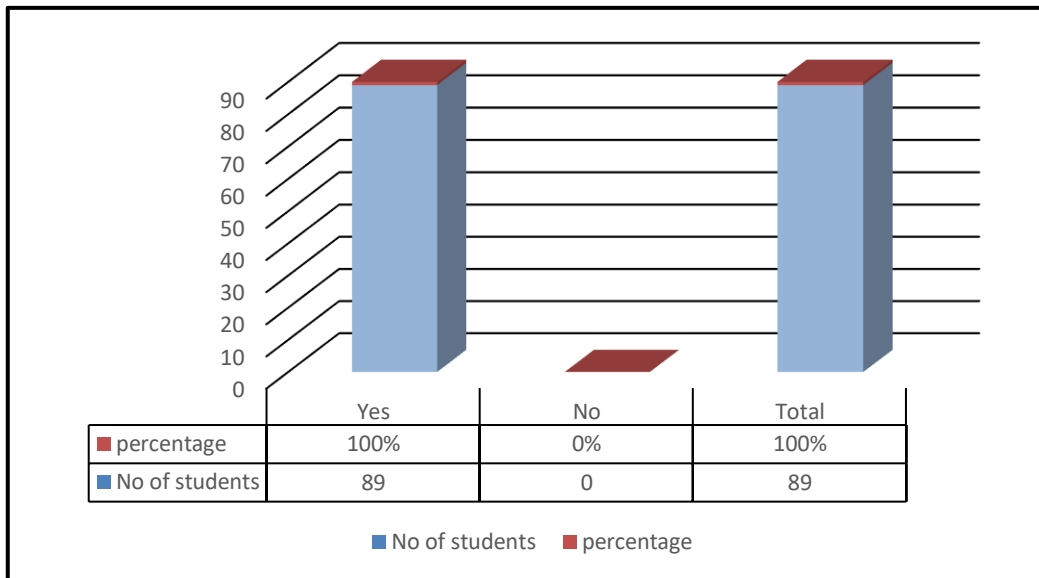
### Q.3) How did participating in the competition increased your motivation to explore further in design or similar fields?

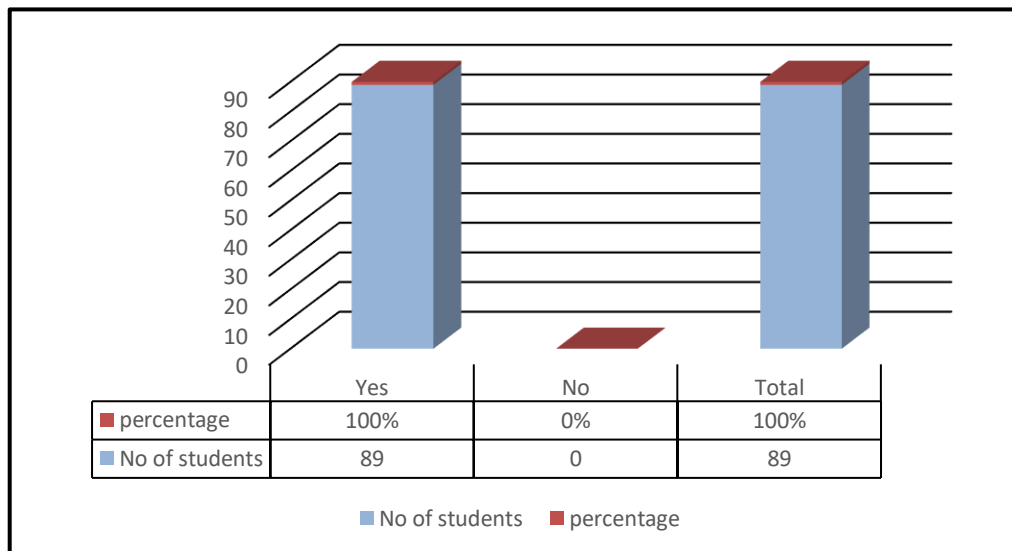
