What is Biodiversity?
The term Biodiversity was first coined by Walter G. Rosen in 1986. The word Biodiversity originates from the Greek word BIOS = LIFE and Latin word VERITAS = VARIETY or DIFFERENCE. The whole word BIO DIVERSITY generally therefore means: VARIETY OF LIFE. Biodiversity is the degree of variation of life. It is a measure of the variety of organism present in different ecosystems.

Biodiversity
Variety of living things, number of kinds
- Ecological diversity - different habitats, niches, species interactions - an assemblage of species living in the same area and interacting with an environment
- Species diversity - different kinds of organisms, relationships, varying species - refers to the number of kinds of species being found
- Genetic diversity - different genes & combinations of genes within populations - show adaptation of a species to adapt to environmental change

Threats to biodiversity
- **Habitat destruction** - Important to protect habitat in order to protect biodiversity within it. Huge pressure from the World's rapidly increasing population.
- **Global climate change** - Change in biotic elements of ecosystems leading to biotic change.
- **Overexploitation** - From human activity. Reduces ability of habitat to support species.
- **Chemical pollution** - Introduction of pollutants such as nutrient overloading with nitrate fertilizer as well as more immediately harmful chemicals.
- **Alien species** - This includes the illegal wildlife trade as well as overfishing, logging of tropical hardwoods etc.
- **Invasive species** - Introduced by humans to regions where there are no natural predators.
- **Diseases** - Reduction in habitat causing high population densities, encourages spread of diseases.

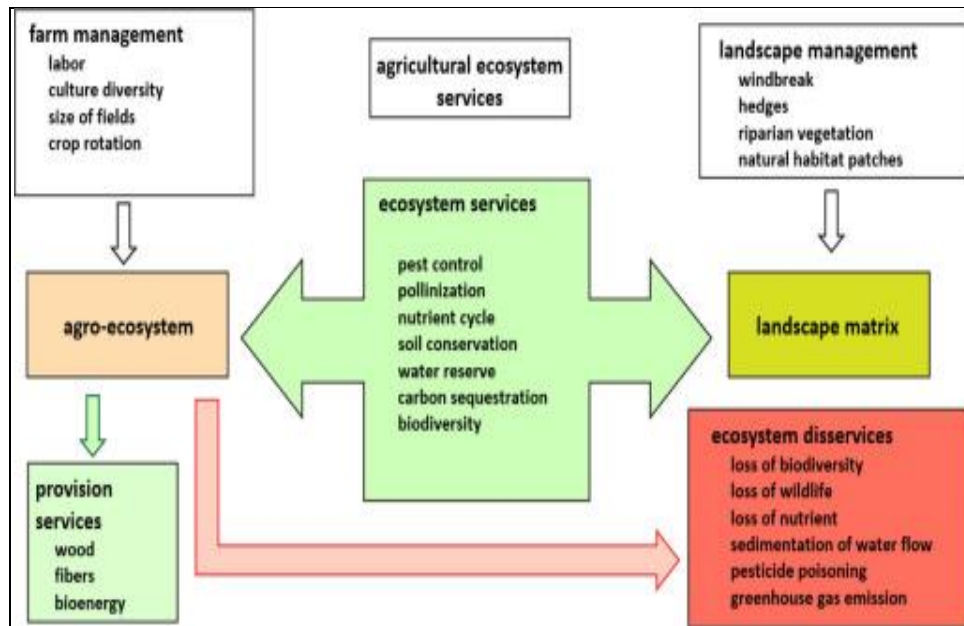

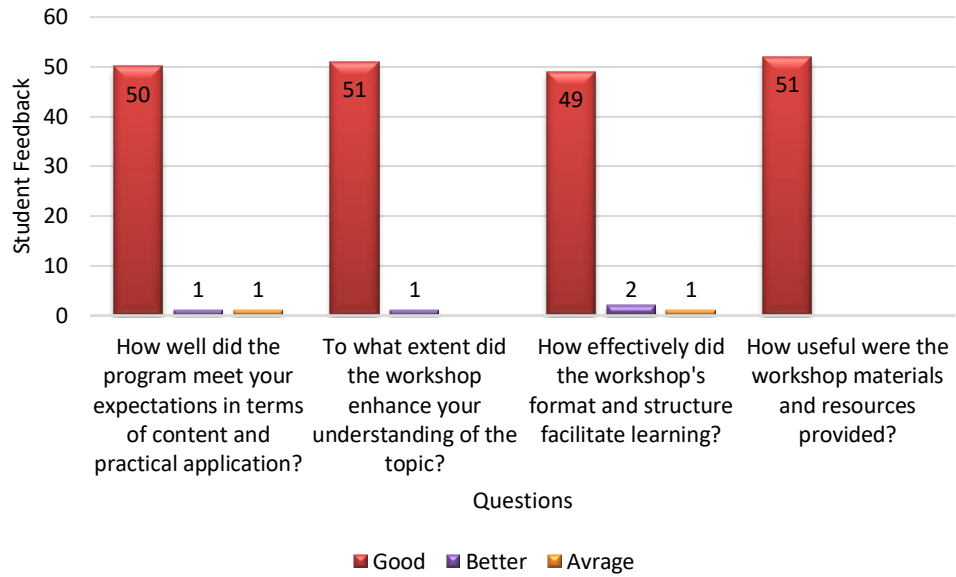
