Prof. R.U.Khope Professor, Head, Department of Chemistry

The department of chemistry is known for its academic ambience. Ours is the biggest department in the college with ten faculty members teaching UG and PG students. The faculty members strive hard for the all round development of students. Keeping the horizontal and vertical growth of an industry and society in mind, Department of Chemistry started M.Sc. course from 2005 with specialization in organic Chemistry and Polymer Chemistry as elective papers.

The department recognized as a centre for higher learning by R.T.M. Nagpur University, Nagpur and eight students are pursuing Ph.D. under the able guidance of our teachers. The department has four well-equipped laboratories for conducting usual practicals and research activities. In order to ensure accuracy in the research pursuit, major instruments like spectrophotometer, conductometer, pH meter, flame photometer, UV Visible Spectrophotometer, centrifuge machine and digital balance etc are available in the laboratory. The research output is quite substantial. The faculty members published research papers in reputed national and international journals.

Department of Chemistry has organized various activities during the session 2022-2023

1. One day state level workshop on topic 'Beneficial Effects of Radiation Technology and Indian Nuclear Energy Programme' organized by the Department under the sponsorship of Indian Association for Radiation Protection (Bhabha Atomic Research Centre), Mumbai as a part of centenary celebration of RTM Nagpur University on 5<sup>th</sup> November 2022. World water day was celebrated on 25/03/2023 to raise the awareness about the fress water and importance of water in human life. On this day advanced water testing kits were distributed to the students of Gondwana and RTMNU University, Nagpur.

# 7. Launching of Chem Clean Concentrate Floor Cleaner

Chem Clean Floor Cleaner Concentrate is a solution made in the Department of Chemistry by Sarang Dhote, an Assistant Professor. It is composed of various chemicals such as Pine oil, Emulsifier, Stabilizer, Demineralised Water, Colour, and Perfume. When 1 litre of the concentrate is diluted, it can make around 40 litres of floor cleaner. This product comes in 8 different fragrances, including Sandalwood, Rise, Jasmine, and Lemon.

As part of the outreach program, diluted Chem Clean Floor Cleaner is distributed free of cost to NMC school Dattatray Nagar. The Department of Chemistry plans to distribute this product to other NMC schools, hospitals, and slum areas under the Swachh Bharat Scheme. The Chem Clean Floor Cleaner is available to college staff and students at a price of 30, and the empty bottles will be refilled with the diluted floor cleaner at a discounted rate as part of the recycling and reuse scheme to reduce plastic pollution.

Overall, Chem Clean Floor Cleaner Concentrate seems like an innovative and costeffective solution for floor cleaning, with a focus on sustainability and environmental friendliness. Its distribution to various institutions and communities is a commendable effort towards promoting hygiene and cleanliness in society.
