Department of Chemistry

The department of chemistry is known for its academic ambience. Ours is the biggest department in the college with ten faculty members teaching UG and PG students. The faculty members strive hard for the all round development of students. The department runs a Post-graduation course (M.Sc.) with specialization in Organic Chemistry and Polymer Chemistry as elective papers. The department is recognized as a centre for higher learning by R.T.M. Nagpur University, Nagpur and eight students are pursuing Ph.D under the guidance of our teachers. The department has four well-equipped laboratories for conducting usual practicals and research activities. In order to ensure accuracy in the research pursuit, major instruments like spectrophotometer, conductivity meter, pH meter, flame photometer, UV Visible Spectrophotometer, ultrasonicator, centrifuge machine and digital balance etc are available in the laboratory. The research output is quite substantial. The faculty members have published research papers in reputed national and international journals.

Departmental Activities:

- 1. "How to File Copyright in India" a hands-On Training Session was organized by the Department of Chemistry and Shivaji Science Innovation and Incubation Centre of the College on 31 October 2023.
