Action Taken / Outcome:


Each session was recorded and included MCQ-based questions based on the video content.


Participants had to submit correct answers for certification, ensuring active engagement and learning.


The symposium attracted a diverse range of participants and speakers, fostering global collaboration and knowledge sharing.






