The College has started Electronics as one of the subjects at B. Sc. (UG) level and thereby Department of Electronics came into existence in the academic year 1984-85 with intake of 40 students at entry level. During the course of time the Department is augmented with 3 full time faculties with 1 contributory and 2 laboratory attendants.

The Department has well experienced teaching faculty. They are working hard in designing and fabricating the experimental modules in the laboratory, in turn saved huge amount of expenditure on readymade experimental modules. They also supports to College Administrations for the benefit of the students and society through different activities. The Department is recipient of a special UGC grant of Rs. 5 Lac under the scheme of restructuring of courses and other Rs. 5 Lac received for 'A College with Potential for Excellence' under the scheme of promotion for Basic Science Research (BSR) during the academic sessions 1984-85 and 2008-2009, utilized for the infrastructural developments and enrichment of the laboratory. The Department has permanent affiliation with Rashtrasantukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University since 1994.
