Action Taken:

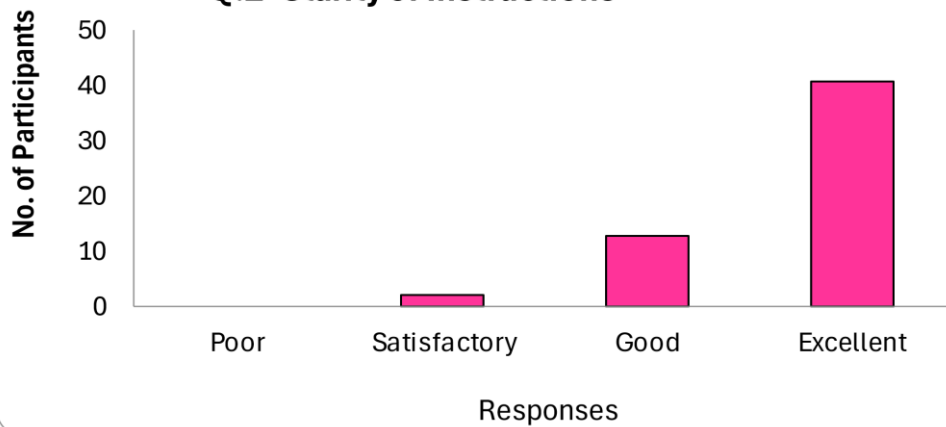

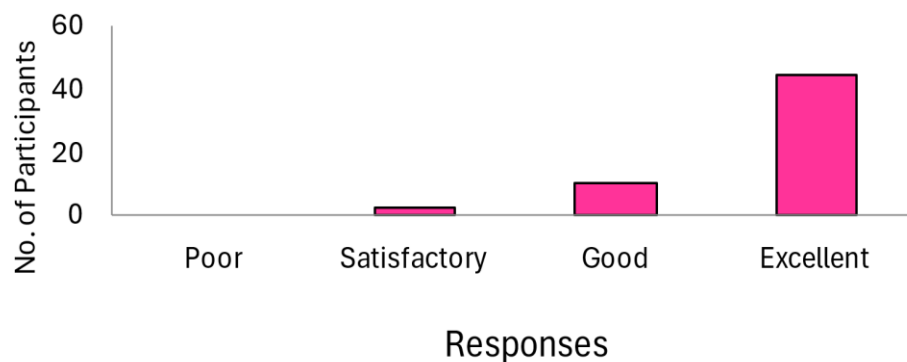

Q.2- Clarity of Instructions



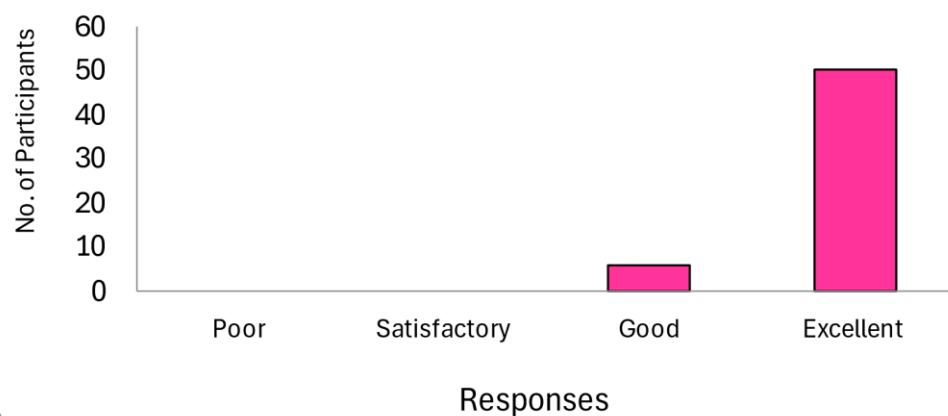

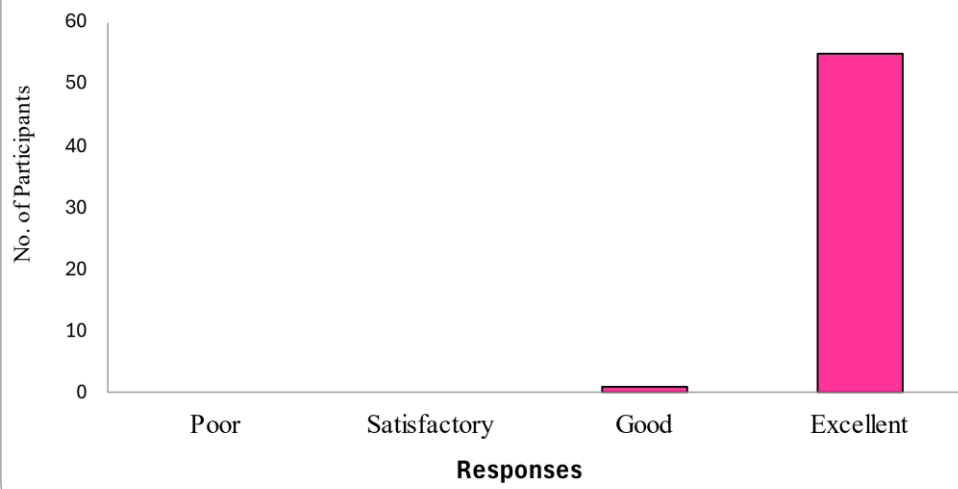
