
About Parent Society and College

Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati was established in 1932 by great visionary leader, Dr. Panjabrao alias Bhausaheb Deshmukh. He was the first Union Agriculture Minister of Independent India and a member of the Draft Committee of the Indian Constitution, an erudite scholar of Sanskrit, a parliamentarian, an agriculturalist, an educationist, and a social reformer. He founded this Education society with the noble aim of taking 'Dnyanganga' that is knowledge to the doorsteps of masses in general and underprivileged rural strata and women in particular. The society offers courses in all disciplines such as Agriculture, Arts, Commerce, Education, Fine Arts, Law, Management, Physical Education, Medicine, Science, Engineering, and Technology. There are 307 institutions all over Vidarbha shaping the character and destiny of thousands of youngsters every year.

Hon'ble Shri Harshvardhan P. Deshmukh, President of Shri Shivaji Education Society is the torchbearer of the ideas propagated by Dr. Panjabrao alias Bhausaheb Deshmukh. The Parent Society is honored with the following awards:

- 'Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar Dalit Mitra Award' in 1993-94 by the Government of Maharashtra.
- 'Gadge Maharaj Memorial Award' in 1999-2000 by the Government of Maharashtra.
- 'Best Administered Society Award' on 5th September 2000 by the Government of Maharashtra.
- 'Maharashtra Nirmata Award' by Social, Scientific and Public Literature Society, Parbhani.

Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati's Science College, Congress Nagar Nagpur is one of the 307 institutions run by the well-known society. Initially, Science College was housed in the existing Dhanwate National College, Nagpur in the year 1960. Later it was shifted to a new building and came into existence as an Independent College in the year 1967. Now it is better known as Shri Shivaji Education Society Amravati's Science College situated at the center of Nagpur city, popularly known as Shivaji Science College. The College was accredited with a 'Five Stars' grade by NAAC, Bengaluru in 2002. Identified as 'A College with Potential for Excellence' (CPE) status by UGC, New Delhi since 2004 (Phase I -2004) (Phase II – 2009) (Phase III-2014). The college was then reaccredited as an 'A' grade College by NAAC, Bengaluru with a CGPA of 3.26 in the 3rd cycle. It was reassessed and reaccredited as an A+ Grade College with a CGPA of 3.51 in the year 2017. The College is a recognized center for higher learning and a member of the Asia Pacific Quality Network (APQN), Shanghai. It is affiliated with Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University, Nagpur. A Mentor College under Paris Sparsh scheme of Maharashtra State.









India's First Agriculture Minister

- Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh was the First Agriculture Minister of India. His dedication to the formulation and implementation of the policies brought prosperity to Agriculture and agriculturists. He established 'Bharat Krishak Samaj' and launched a campaign called 'Food for Millions' in 1955. He brought in the 'Japanese method of Rice Cultivation' in 1958.
- The 'World Agriculture Fair' was organized by him in 1959, and was inaugurated by the then President of the US, Dwight Eisenhower. The fair was visited by dignitaries and received a massive response from the World.
- He started establishing agricultural universities across the country and supported agricultural education, research, and related extension activities. He wanted to ensure that the beneficiary of all this enterprise would be the ordinary farmer.





Welfare for Peasants and Farmers

In the era of globalization, India is facing the problem of farmer suicides. In spite of many packages, committees, suicides of farmers do not stop. The reason behind this failure is the lack of vision of the Government. Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh while speaking on a welfare of peasants and farmers, strongly appealed to establish welfare board for farmers on the line of social welfare board which will take care of farmer's education, health and sanitation. He regrets that drafting committee of the constitution has not considered the problems of peasants and farmers in the country. He wrote a letter to Dr. Rajendra Prasad, Chairman of the Constitution Committee on $12^{\rm th}$ March 1948 to address the issues of farmers and lack of representation of farmers on the Constitution committee.

The views of Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh are straight forward and pragmatic as a Union Minister of Agriculture. Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh made a revolution in agriculture by introducing world agriculture technology to Indian farmers community. He believed on exchange of technology and organized world agriculture exhibition at Delhi. Eisenhower - the U.S. President visited India for inaugurating the world agriculture exhibition on $11^{\rm th}$ Dec. 1959. Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh published circular letters of his ministry to update all the State and Union Ministers Departments about agriculture development and advancement. Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh took every efforts for the welfare of peasants and farmers in the country. His commitments with farmers were strong and highly commendable.



The First World Agriculture Fair was organized by Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh on 11th December 1959- 11th March 1960 in Delhi, India while being the Union Agriculture Minister & President of Bharat Krishak Samaj. The fair had an overwhelming response from the world & millions of Farmers visited the exhibition. The fair was inaugurated by Dr. Rajendra Prasad, the then President of India with Mr. Dwight D. Eisenhower, President of the USA, and Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru, PM of India. During the 92 days exhibition leaders and dignitaries across the globe marked their attendance. The exhibition stall of the USSR and the USA was the largest and attracted the farmers to new agriculture innovations and technology. The exhibition was a landmark in the history of Indian agriculture which provided a global platform to the agriculture fraternity. The Year 2019 is marked as the Diamond Jubilee Year of the World Agriculture Fair and is celebrated to remember the initiatives and efforts of great visionary, Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh in uplifting Farmers in the era of crises in agriculture around the world.



Role as Social Reformer



Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh as a Social Reformer

Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh was a progressive and pragmatic social reformer who took the initiative of opening Amba Devi Temple untouchables and compelled the trusty to allow untouchables in the temple. The reason behind this movement was not only to open the temple for untouchables but also to give equal rights to the deprived section of society. He was a follower of Satya Shodhak Samaj of Mahatma Phuley. Likewise, Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh started Shraddhanand Hostel which was accessed by all the sections of the society. His work was towards humanity and the welfare of downtrodden people. Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh was also a lawyer and practiced law. He appeared for poor peasants in many cases at the district court of Amravati. His most predominant case was the British Government vs Azad Hind Sena, in which he assisted Jawaharlal Nehru. His commitments to rural people were strong and tried to uplift the rural people from the heavy darkness of backwardness.



Establishment of Lokvidyapith and Contribution Towards Education



Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh founded Lokvidyapith on 30th Dec.1950 which was inaugurated by the then President Hon'ble Dr. Rajendra Prasad. Contribution for Constitution of Republic India


Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh made a useful contribution as a member of the Draft Committee for the Constitution of the Republic India chaired by Dr. Bhimrao R. Ambedkar. He has devoted his efforts as a member of the drafting committee for making the Constitution of India from Central Provinces and Berar. In November 1946, the Constitution Assembly was formed with Dr. Rajendra Prasad being appointed as the President of the Committee. On 26th November 1949, the "Constitution of India" was passed and adopted by the assembly. The Constitution of India came into force on 26th January 1950, which we celebrate as Republic Day of India.

Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh insisted on accepting parliamentary democracy. On speaking with the draft Constitution, he said that parliamentary democracy is essentially meant for maintaining the status. It is meant to bring about radical change from the existing state of affairs. Further, he said, he would not be surprised if this constitution does not last long, because it does not answer the aspiration of the man in the street at present. He observed that the principles of equality, liberty, and fraternity adopted in the constitution will lose their significance in two hundred years. Under these phrases, it has been possible for various countries to maintain the upper layers where they were and to exploit the lower ranks to their hearts' content. He warned there would have to be some sort of rebellion or revolution if we do not get proper representatives to run the Government with this Constitution.

EDUCATION AS MEANS OF SOCIAL REFORM



Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh not only founded Shri Shivaji Education Society but also made the provision for primary education by increasing the local cess by 50% which could embark an extensive program of compulsory education to the doorsteps of masses in general and under-privileged rural states and women in particular. Radhakrishnan, Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh declared his mission of education as follows "Let other Universities devote their money and energies to the production of only supermen. Let my Universities and Lokvidyapith strive to make useful, patriotic men and women out of ignorance, filth, poverty, and misery in the heavy darkness of India."
