**Rules:**

1. Calendar is for 1st January 2022 - 31st December 2022.
2. Number of participants: Group of Five.
3. Size of Calendar page: 44cm (L) X 28cm (B)-One separate page for one month.
4. Background of page is white. Letters and material should be in black or blue. This is for front page.
5. In 3/4th part, date blocks for 30/31 days must be adjusted in equal size blocks.
6. For every month, mark different important days which should include only specific days of scientific importance for example- birth/death anniversaries of Scientists in the field of microbiology, biotechnology and allied subjects/ important discoveries or inventions or days like world environment day/ science day etc. Include INDEPENDENCE DAY, REPUBLIC DAY & BHAUSAHEB JAYANTI.
7. Remaining 1/4th portion is for giving information about important days of that month. For this, font should be Times New Roman-Size 12. Heading should be bold with font size 18.
8. On back side, give Microbiology/Biotechnology related information e.g. information about important research institutions/ educational institutes, different/ unique courses etc. from India.
9. On front page of each month, Name of our college with address & website as well as name of Microbiologists Society, India must be given at right corner bottom in blue letters.

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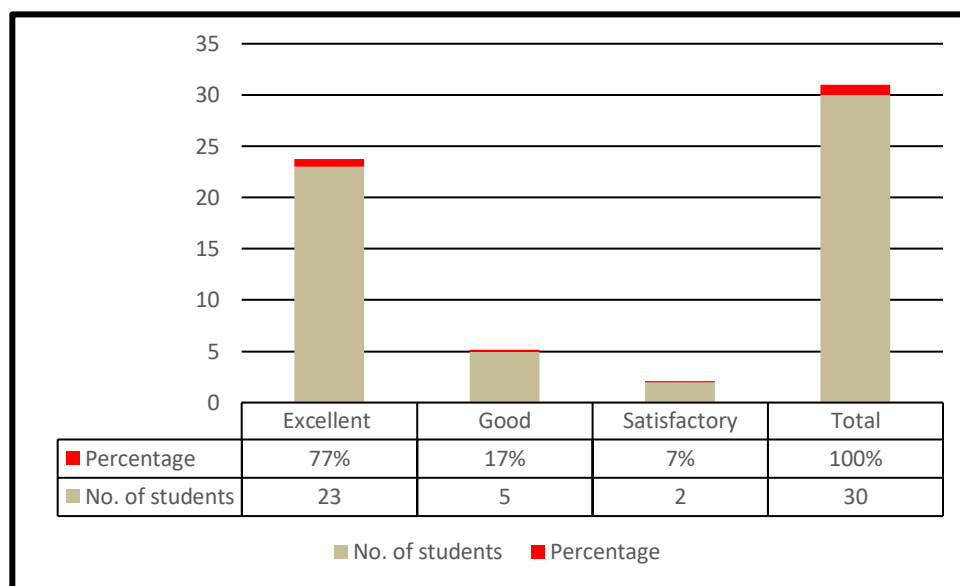

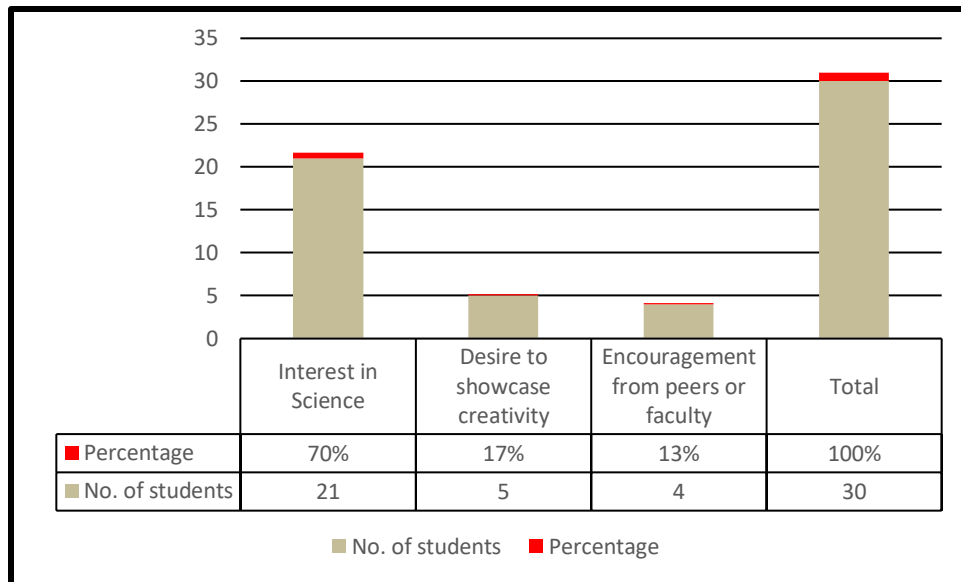
Q.1) How would you assess the overall organization of the competition?

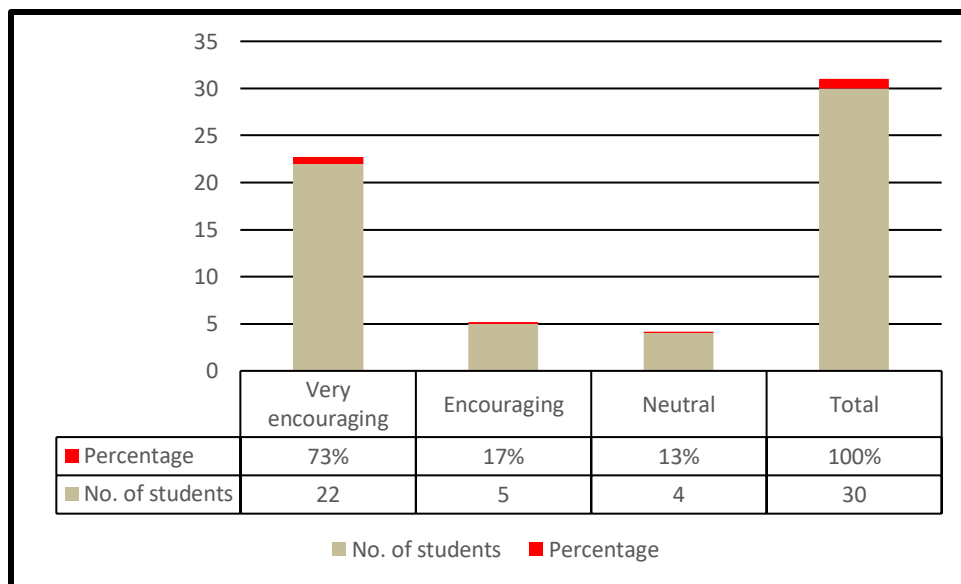
## Q.2) What motivated you to participate in the competition?

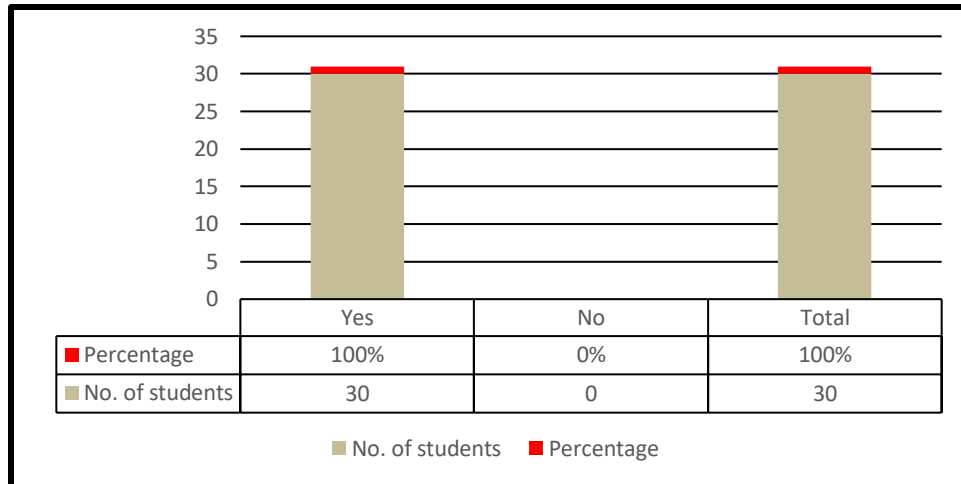
## Q.3) How did you feel about the competition theme of "Life Science"?

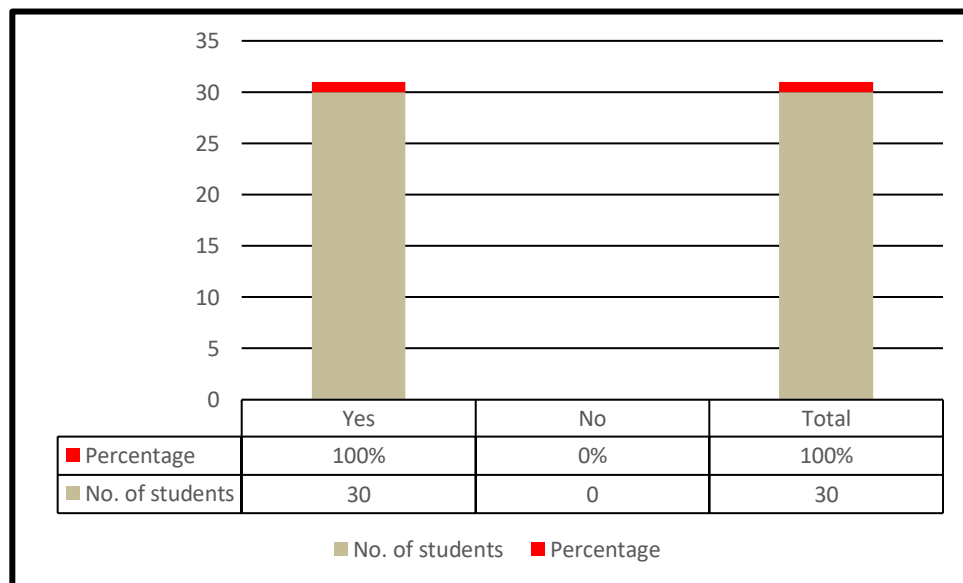
