Submission Format: Please compose your Jingle, record it and prepare a video file (.mp4) with the image of lyrics as background and share the youtube link of this video file in online Registration form or upload the video file on telegram group.

Evaluation Criteria: The entries to the Jingle competition will be evaluated in terms of their creativity, originality, composition, simplicity and also on the basis of:

- Lyrics:** The quality of the lyrics will be evaluated depending on the content, emotional appeal, relevance, rhyme of words, etc.
- Audio:** The quality of the audio will be evaluated depending on the rhythm, pitch, flow, tone, emotion, etc.
- To qualify in the final shortlist of winning entry/ entries, candidates must submit a jingle that is concise, has a catchy rhyme, empowering, or puns and can create general awareness among the public on the Social distancing norms (rules).

Prize Money: The prizes are as follows:

- 1st Prize: Rs. 1,000/-
- 2nd Prize: Rs. 750/-
- 3rd Prize: Rs. 500/-

Certificate: Certificate of Participation to all the contestants.

Terms & Conditions for Jingle Competition:

- The competition is open to all the students of Science College, Congress Nagar, Nagpur only.
- Theme of the Jingle Competition is Social Distancing norms (rules) to be followed to stop Corona virus from spreading.
- Duration of Jingles should not be more than 3 minutes including contestant's name, class and email ID.

- All the entries will be submitted online in Registration form.

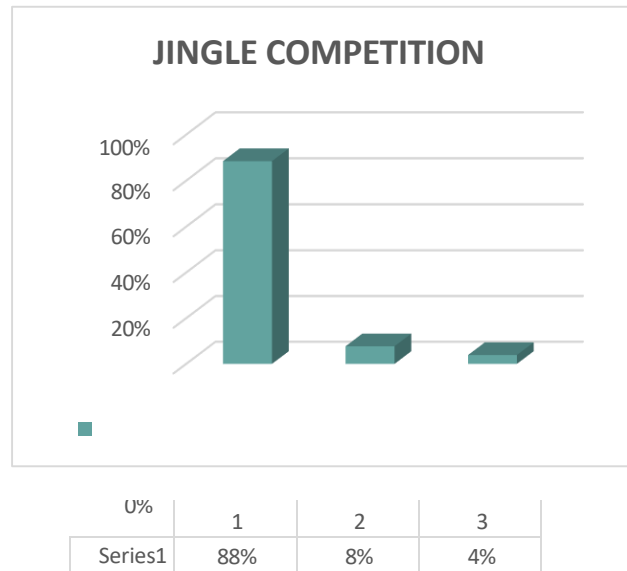

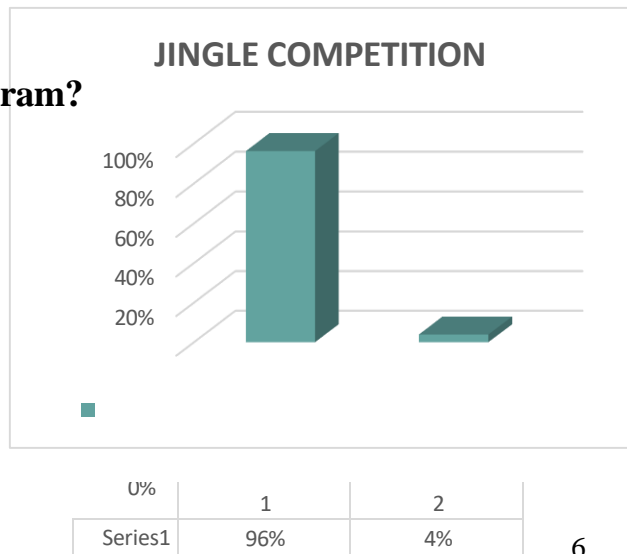
Q.1) How will you rate this competition?

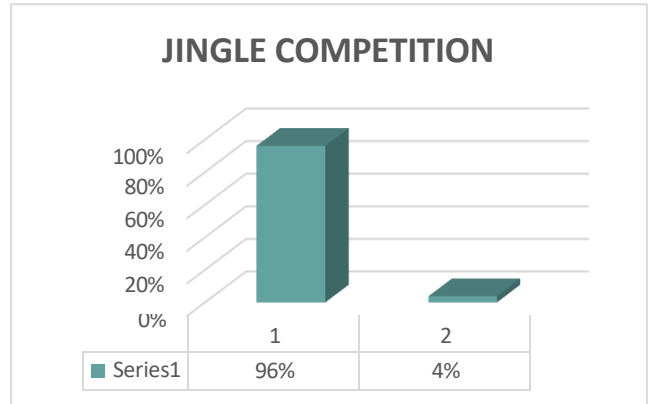
Q.2) How satisfied are you with this program?

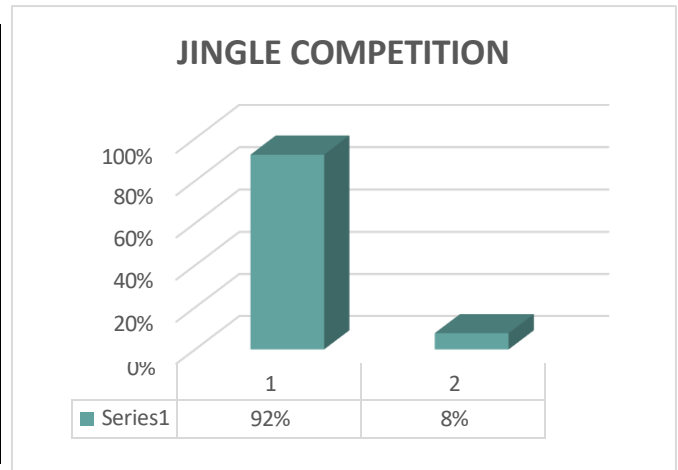

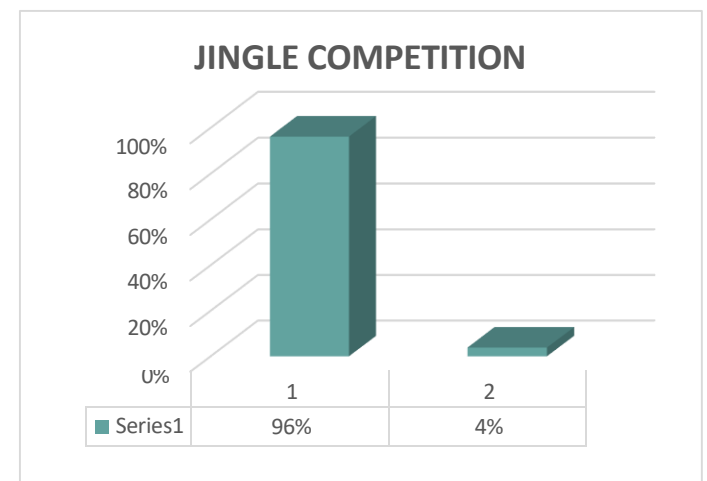
