Department organizes workshops on statistical software exclusively for students of the department.

Commemorating the pioneering efforts and contribution of world renowned Statistician Prof. P.C.Mahalanobis for our country, department celebrates every year 29th June, National Statistics day, on his birthday, to make our students aware of the rich heritage of Statistics. This year also it is celebrated with great enthusiasm. Mr. Bhavesh Popali explained importance of the day. Mr. Pradyumna Shembekar presented work of Prof. P.C.Mahalanobis. Ms. Nandini Jain and Ms. Shivani Agrawal explained the concept of probability through model. They have also prepared a model of Pascal Triangle and explained its use very nicely. Mrs. M.A.Pande presided over the function. She greeted newly admitted first year students and introduced them various projects carried out by the students of the department. Ms. Sakshi Pande conducted the programme.

To increase interaction of students with faculty, the statistical society has been constituted every year.
