**Lecture Series Commemorating Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh's Contributions to Agriculture and Education**

**Place:** Nanded Education Society's Science College, Nanded.

**Topic:** The educational and agricultural revolution envisioned by Dr. Punjabrao Deshmukh

To honour the legacy of Dr. Panjabrao alias Bhausaheb Deshmukh, a series of 125 lectures was organized by Shri Shivaji Shikshan Sanstha across various schools and colleges, including institutions outside our educational network. Dr. Deshmukh's profound contributions to education, society, and agriculture continue to serve as inspiration, promising immense benefits to future generations. In his introductory address, Principal Dr. Mahendra Dhore of Shivaji Science College, Congress Nagar, Nagpur, emphasized that the values and ideas upheld by Dr. Deshmukh should reach every corner of Maharashtra, ultimately shaping the society envisioned by this great leader.

Dr. Bhausaheb Deshmukh is historically recognized for his transformative work in religion, society, education, and agriculture. Following in the footsteps of social reformers like Phule and Ambedkar, he opposed caste discrimination and was a strong critic of both casteism and theistic superstitions. His role as a visionary leader in societal reform has been etched into India's history. Alongside revolutionaries like Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil of Satara and Bhau Sahib Hire of Nashik, Dr. Deshmukh's contributions to education were revolutionary and enduring. He believed that the goal of human life was to live with values and that education was the foundation for achieving such a life.

In this spirit, the lecture series was organized to promote Dr. Deshmukh's vision, aiming to instil his ideals in today's generation. Dr. Deshmukh stressed the need for educational and agricultural revolutions to build a strong nation. According to him, education and agriculture form the backbone of India, and ensuring their strength was crucial to the country's progress. His establishment of Shri Shivaji Shikshan Sanstha reflected his commitment to spreading education across all levels of society. Former Principal Dr.

Chandrashekhar K. Chandekar, in his address, highlighted Dr. Deshmukh's contributions, stating that agricultural-based industries and educational reforms were essential for India's development.

Dr. Deshmukh also envisioned the creation of agriculture-based and agro-processing industries to transform rural India. His dedication to these sectors helped advance both education and agriculture in the country. Dr. D. U. Gavai, Principal of Science College Nanded, expressed gratitude to Dr. Deshmukh in his presidential speech, stating that as a student from a modest background, it was due to the education offered by institutions established by Dr. Deshmukh that he was able to rise to his current position.

The lecture, titled "**The Educational and Agricultural Revolution envisioned by Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh**", was jointly organized by Shri Shivaji Shikshan Sanstha's Science College, Nagpur, and Nanded Education Society's Science College, Nanded. The event featured prominent speakers, including Dr. D. U. Gavai, Dr. Mahendra Dhore, Dr. C. K. Chandekar, Dr. L. P. Shinde, and Dr. P. S. Changole. The program was smoothly conducted by Dr. Aruna Shukla, and it saw the enthusiastic participation of faculty members, non-teaching staff, and students from Shivaji Science College.

This lecture series aimed to inspire the youth to follow the ideals of Dr. Deshmukh and take up the mantle of advancing education and agriculture, which he believed were the pillars of national progress.
