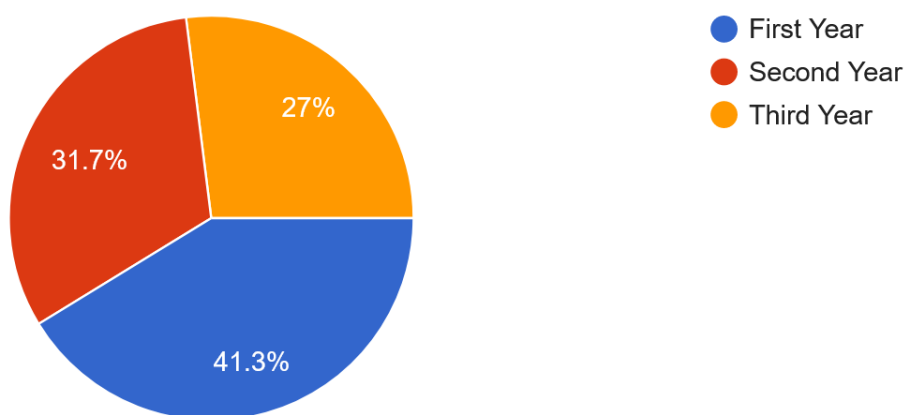

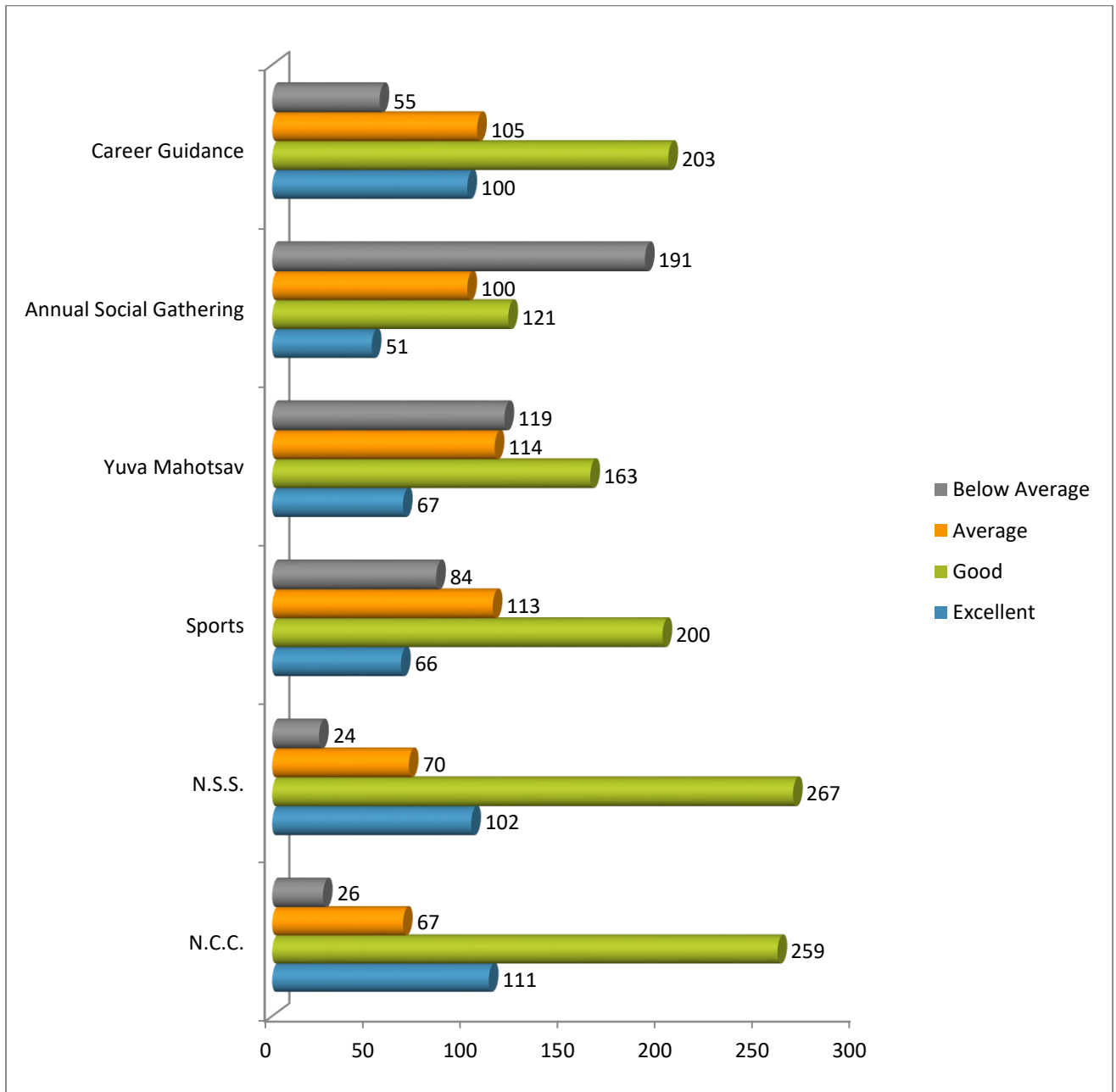

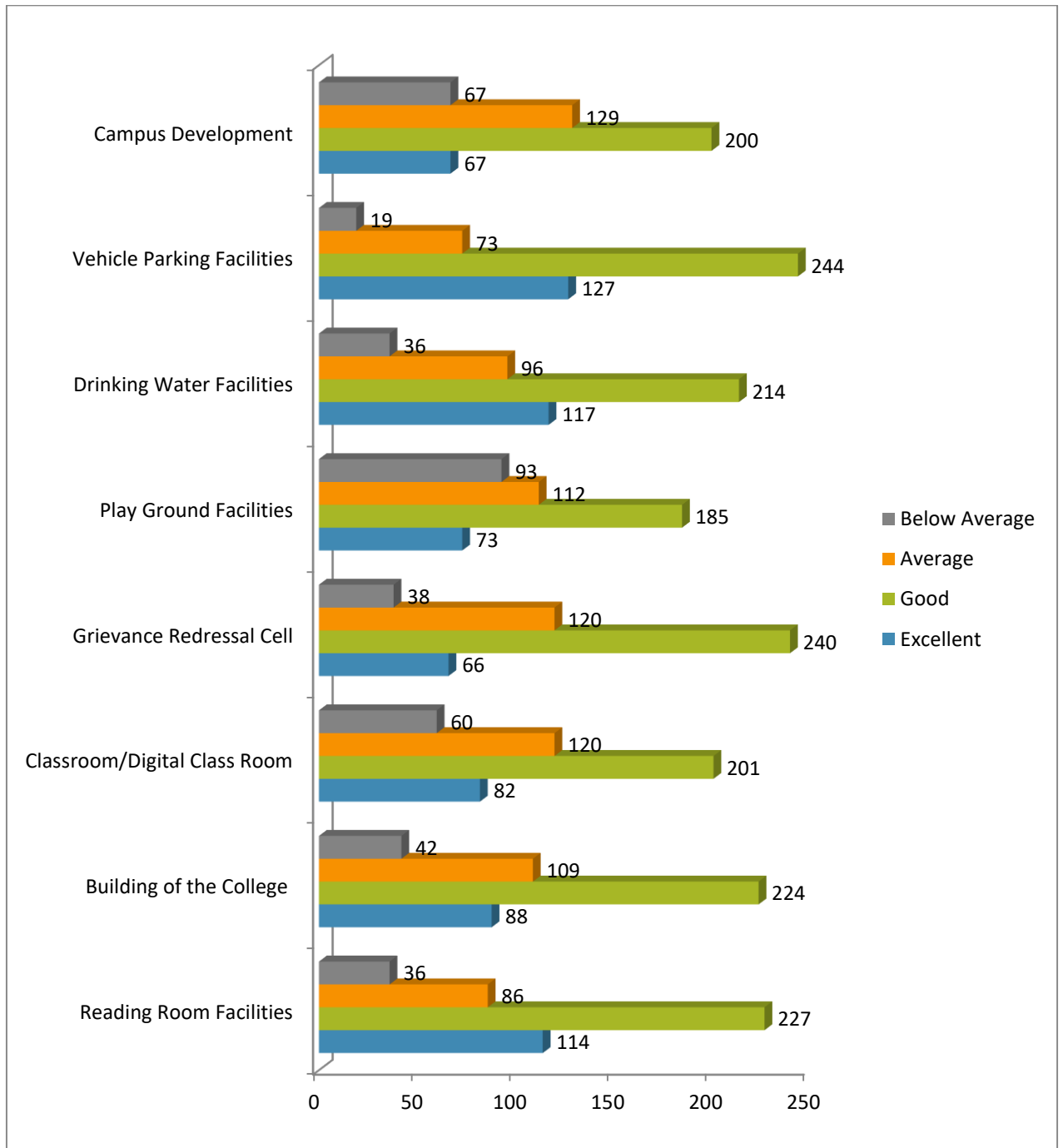

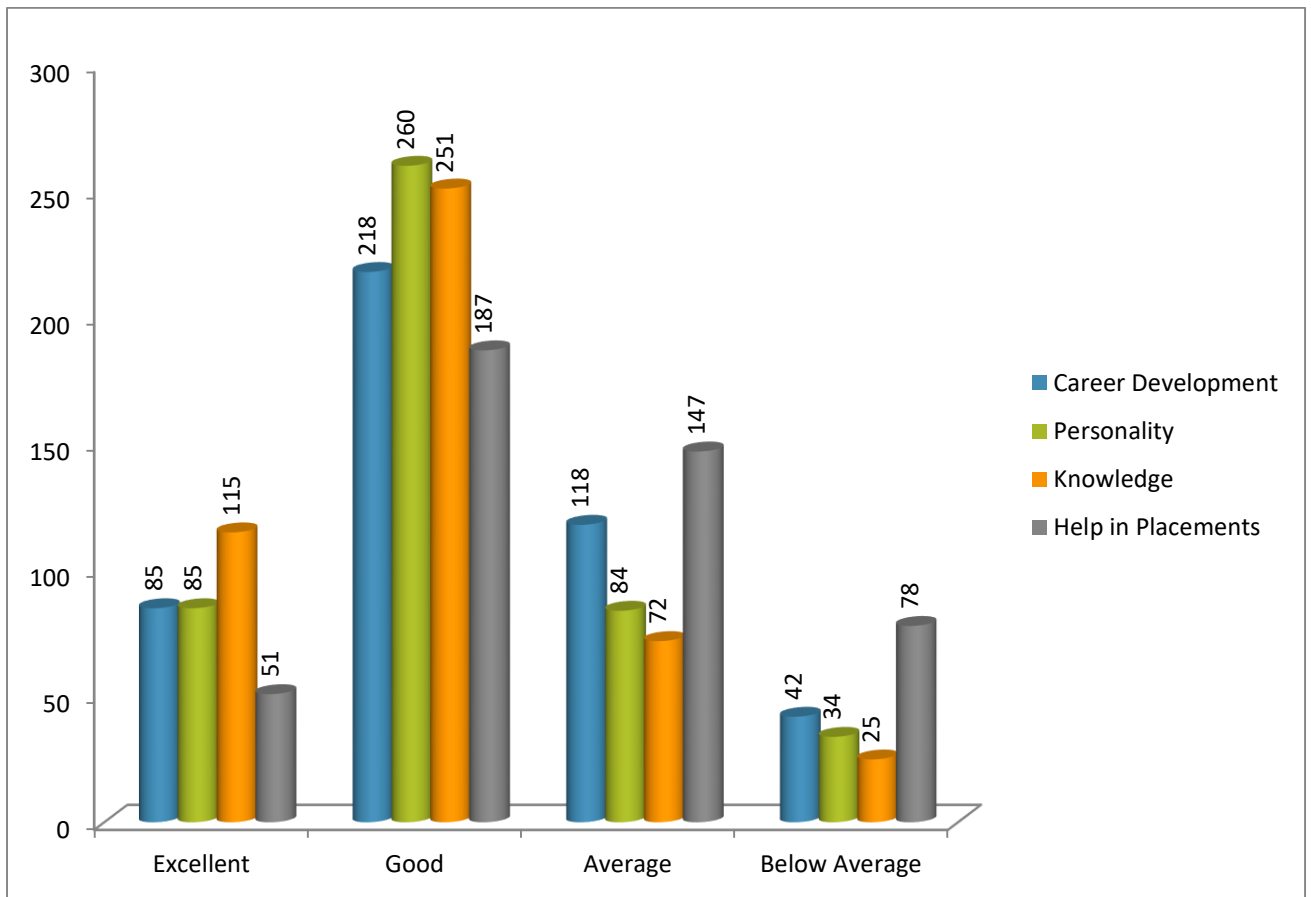

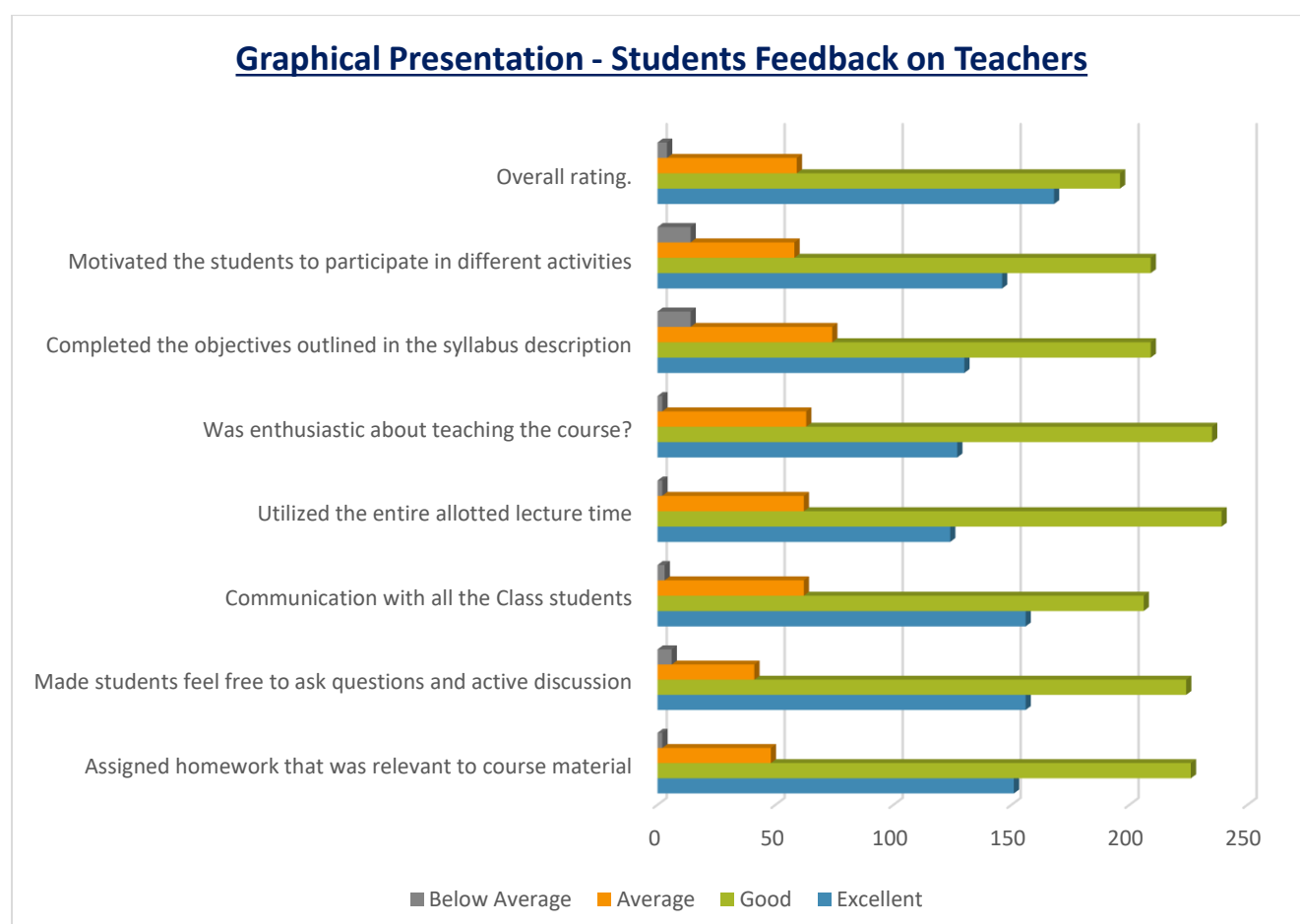

# Feedback Report (2023-2024)

## **Findings of feedback report session 2023-2024:**

The college has the mechanism for analyzing student's feedback on institutional performance. The feedback is obtained from the following stakeholders:

1. Students feedback on curriculum
2. Students feedback on College (Overall)
3. Students Feedback on Teachers
4. Feedback/Suggestions from Parents
5. Feedback from Alumni

### **1. Students Feedback on Curriculum:**

A feedback from students is obtained through feedback form containing questionnaire on various aspects of curriculum like relevance to real life situation, employability, entrepreneurship, skill development, learning objectives, practical and field work component, depth of the course content, inclusion/incorporation of latest advancements in the subject, difficulty level of course content, optimization of course outcomes, relevance of course outcomes. The feedback analysis is as follows:

1. Students are satisfied with respect to applicability to real life situation & local developmental needs of their course content and course outcomes.
2. Students are also satisfied with employability, entrepreneurship, skill development, hands on experiments, practical, study tour and field work component.
3. Few of students faced the difficulty level of course content and incorporation of latest advancements in the subject.
4. Most of the students are satisfied with learning objectives and values.
5. Students are satisfied with teacher's domain knowledge of the subject and their availability in the college, sincerity and teaching methodology.

### **2. Students Feedback on College at a glance (Overall):**

A feedback from students is obtained through feedback form containing questionnaire on Academics (Teaching activities, Library, Availability of Books, Reading Room Facility, Conduct of Examinations, Co-operation of Principal/Teachers/Office Staff/Non-teaching Staff, Innovative teaching methods), Extra-Curricular activities, Non-Academics (Reading Room Facilities, College building, Classrooms/Digital Class Rooms, Grievance Redressal Cell, Play Ground Facilities, Drinking Water Facilities, Vehicle Parking Facilities, Campus Development), Contribution of the College in Career Development, Personality development, Knowledge, Help in Placements. The feedback analysis is as follows:

1. Teachers explain the subject effectively & utilize the entire allotted lecture time.
2. Teachers completed the syllabus in due course of time.

3. Most of the teachers completed the objectives outlined in the syllabus description.
4. Made students feel free to ask query related to study, course, career and active participation in discussion inside & outside the classroom.
5. Motivated the students to participate in different activities like Research science project, Quiz Competition, Seminar presentation, Debate competition, Group discussion, Poster presentation, Inter-collegiate Science exhibition, Blood donation, Rangoli competition, etc.
6. The students agreed that the assigned homework was relevant to course material.
7. Study material was provided to the students.
8. Library, laboratory, internet facilities and maintenance of general amenities are pertinent.
9. Most of the students are satisfied with extra-curricular activities like N.C.C., N.S.S., Sports, **Yuva Mahotsav**, Career Guidance, Guest lecture, Cyber awareness program, etc. conducted in college.
10. The students are satisfied with non-academic facilities in the college like, reading room, class rooms, smart rooms, drinking water, playground, sports.
11. Students are getting the help in Career development, skill development, training and placement.

1. Overall assigned homework were relevant to course material.
2. Most of the students freely asked questions and made active discussion.
3. Very good communication with all the Class students
4. Most of the students said that the objectives outlined in the syllabus was completed in time.
5. Motivated the students to participate in different activities in the college as well as University and other colleges also.

The benefits of **MoUs** are:

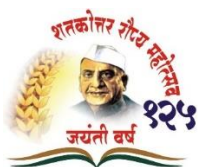

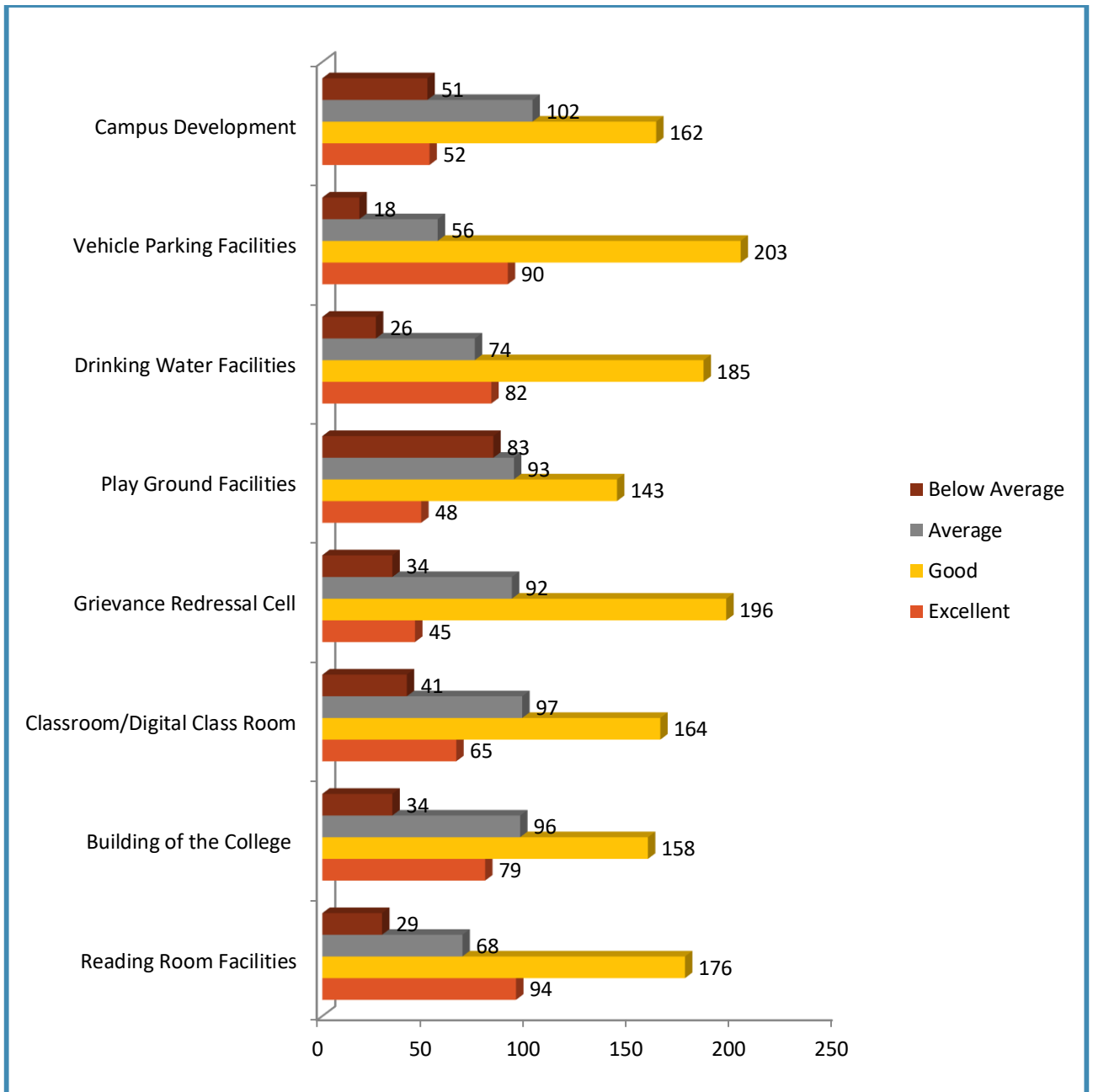

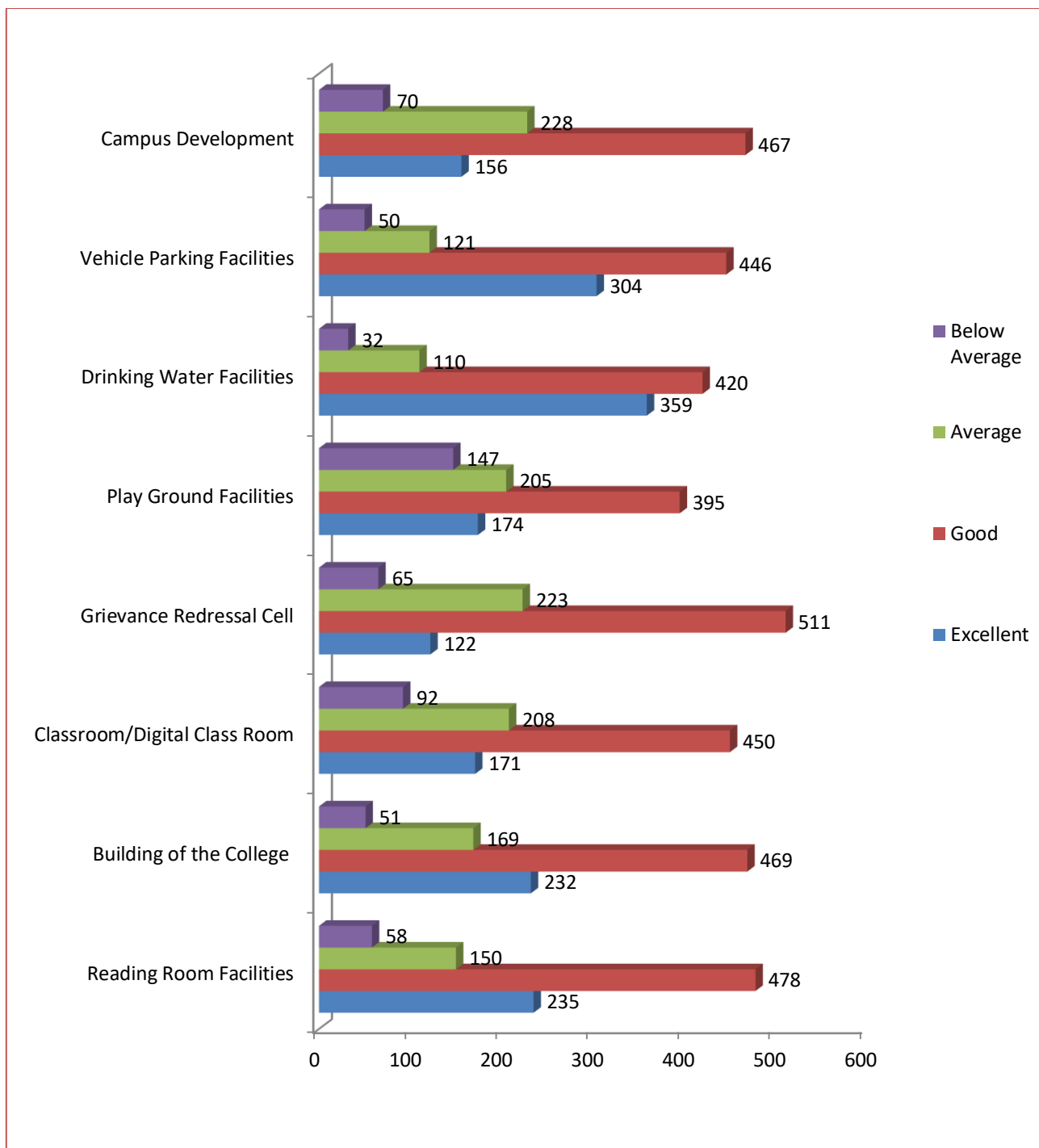

### Feedback on Facilities Provided to Students



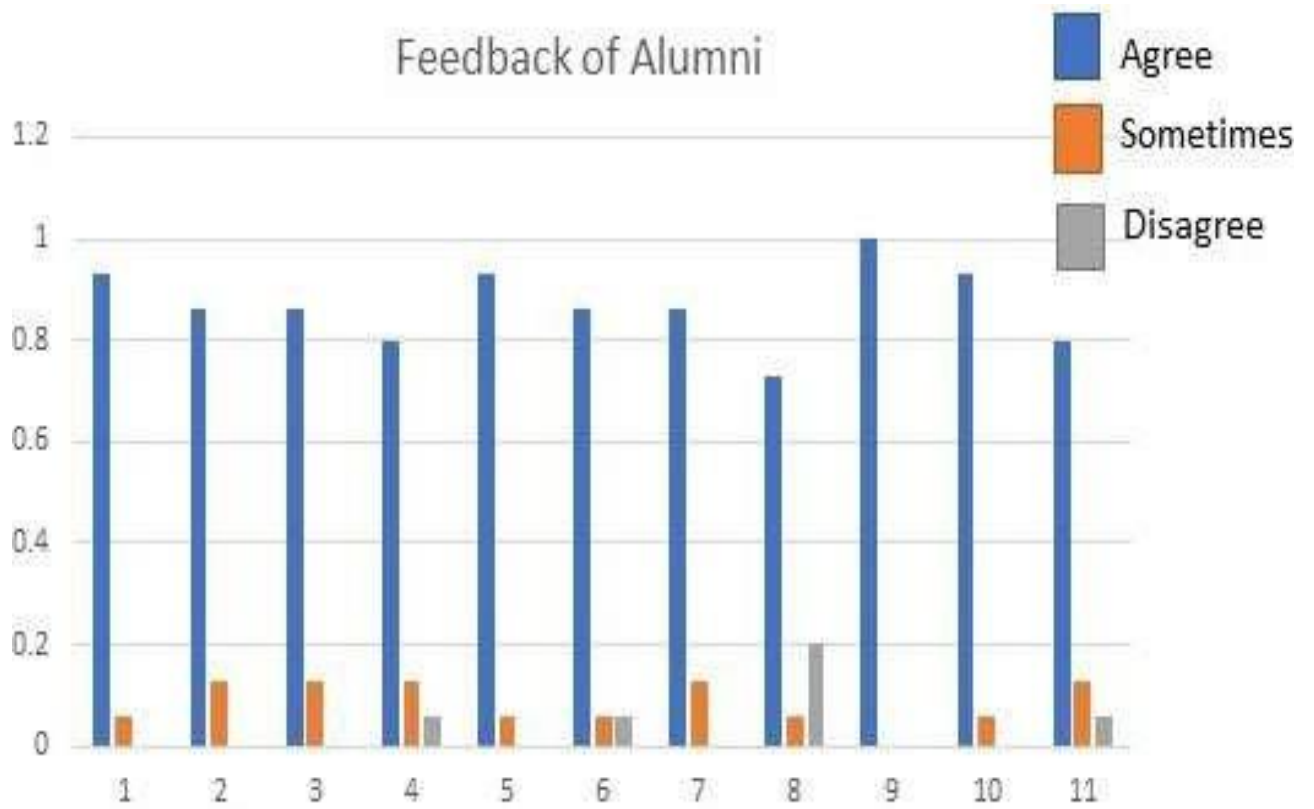

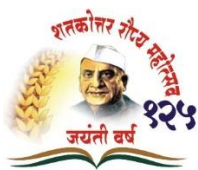
